

György Ligeti (1923-2006) was a leading Hungarian-born composer of the branch of avant-garde music concerned principally with shifting masses of sound and tone colours.

This year marks the 100-year anniversary of the composer's birthday. The project proposal of a Ligeti Institute intends to pay an homage to a unique musical oeuvre.

Beyond the scope of a research center of the Ligeti estate, as well as the Hungarian classical music heritage of the second half of the 20th century, the project includes small-scale performance venues. exhibition, education and communal spaces, archives and library. It is an open meeting place for musicians, researchers and music lovers.

Detailed program will be provided. Proposal and evaluation of potential project sites is part of the project.
